GOSPEL ACCLAMATION


Alleluia, alleluia! I am the good shepherd, says the Lord; I know my sheep, and mine know me. Alleluia! GOSPEL JN 10:11-18

IN 10:14

The hired man, since he is not the shepherd and the sheep do not belong to him, abandons the sheep and runs away as soon as he sees a wolf coming, and then the wolf attacks and scatters the sheep: this is because he is only a hired man and has no concern for the sheep. I am the good shepherd; I know my own and my own know me, just as the Father knows me and I know the Father; and I lay down my life for my sheep. And there are other sheep I have that are not of this fold, and these I have to lead as well. They too will listen to my voice, and there will be only one flock and one shepherd. The Father loves me, because I lay down my life in order to take it up again. No one takes it from me; I lay it down of my own free will, and as it is in my power to lay it down, so it is in my power to take it up again; and this is the command I have been given by my Father.'

The Good News

(excerpt from CathNews)

A new seven-part, immersive audio podcast -Bringing His Spirit Home: Private Arthur Thomas Walker, Ngarrindjeri Anzac, commissioned by the Virtual War Memorial Australia was launched in Adelaide. The podcast explores the remarkable WW1 journey of Ngarrindjeri Anzac, Private Arthur Thomas Walker. He served in and lost his life in a muddy field in France in August 1916; becoming one of the thousands of soldiers with "no known grave". Despite dying in a war deemed "illegal" for him to enlist in, Walker's legacy persists through his family's active commemoration. Walker was a Ramindjeri man of the Ngarrindjeri nation, who left his home in Goolwa, SA in 1915 to serve in Gallipoli. Walker's story creates an opportunity to explore exactly what the term Anzac means, and what the Anzac spirit entails. "This was a very emotional podcast to be part of," Elder Uncle John Lochowiak, Walker's great-grandson said. "Even though my mother told us stories about her grandfather, there was a lot we didn't know. This is not just about Arthur Thomas Walker, it's about all our people who served."
