SECOND READING

2 TIM 1:6-8, 13-14



Within your will, O Lord, all things are established, and there is none that can resist your will.

LK 17:5-10





#### (Reflection by Greg Sunter) How much faith does one have to have?

How much faith is enough? How is it possible to measure one person's faith against another? When the disciples asked Jesus to increase their faith, what exactly were they asking of him? Is it their faith in God; their faith in themselves; or their faith in the people they are called to serve? The response by Jesus suggests that, in fact, it is faith in all these things. Faith in God and faith in self are intrinsically linked and Jesus makes plain to the disciples that this faith must find its expression in selfless service to others.

Jesus counters their request by telling them that if they had faith the size of a tiny mustard seed they could accomplish great things. It's not a matter of how much faith one has but what they do with it. How much faith does it take to do great things? Jesus says that it only takes the tiniest scrap of faith.

Jesus follows up this statement by pointing out to the disciples that no matter how small the amount of faith, it carries with it a responsibility and duty to act upon it. The gift of faith carries with it a duty to live that faith and act upon it. Jesus makes clear that they are being called to give their lives to faith in service of others without expecting any return – just as Jesus does!
